




Please contact Marcia for more information, Marcia_Pistone@charter.net or 541 884-3026 or 892-2265.	<b>Formed by the Gospels</b> <b>"Blessed are the meek"</b> <b>Matthew 5:5</b>  The Catechism teaches that the Beatitudes proceed in an ascending order, so that each depends upon prior ones. That means understanding "Blessed are the meek" is dependent upon understanding "Blessed are the poor in spirit" and "Blessed are they who mourn". As we have already considered, those two Beatitudes amount to, first, understanding that all human beings are dependent upon God like little children, and second, that no one can be truly happy while the world is broken and wounded by original sin and personal sins. "Blessed are the meek" is to be understood upon those building blocks. The fruit of being poor in spirit and mourning over our brokenness is being humbled and realizing that God's will ought to supersede ours, because He knows better than us what is best for us. Two examples of this in Jesus' life are when he said, "I have not come to do my will, but the will of Him who sent me" and in the Garden of Gethsemane when he said, "not my will, but Yours be done". Jesus was meek/humble, enabling him to perfectly align his will with his Father's will, because he knew he was completely dependent upon the Father and felt deeply the brokenness of the world around him. Like with Jesus, the route to true happiness necessarily passes through complete dependence upon our Father, coming to terms with the brokenness of the world, including us, and aligning our wills with our Father's will through genuine meekness/humility.
<b>Catechism Catechesis</b>  Prayer and liturgy  1073 The liturgy is also a participation in Christ's own prayer addressed to the Father in the Holy Spirit. In the liturgy, all Christian prayer finds its source and goal. Through the liturgy the inner man is rooted and grounded in "the great love with which [the Father] loved us" in his beloved Son. It is the same "marvelous work of God" that is lived and internalized by all prayer, "at all times in the Spirit."
