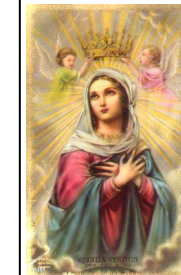

**Crowning of Mary—May 5th**

Please arrive 15 minutes early to Mass next Sunday, May 5th to participate in a crowning of Mary. The First Communion children will present roses and a crown to Our Lady to express the heart of the people towards the Mother of the Church.

Why do Catholics Crown Mary? The Catechism of the Catholic Church says...“The Church’s devotion to the Blessed Virgin is intrinsic to Christian worship.” (CCC971)

The words of St. John Paul II, “The Queen symbol was attributed to Mary because she was the perfect follower of Christ, who is the absolute ‘crown’ of creation.

“By her complete adherence to the Father’s will, to his Son’s redemptive work, and to every prompting of the Holy Spirit, the Virgin Mary is the Church’s model of faith and charity.” (CCC 967)

“In a wholly singular way she cooperated by her obedience, faith, hope, and burning charity in the Savior’s work of restoring supernatural life to souls. For this reason she is a mother to us in the order of grace.” (CCC 968)
