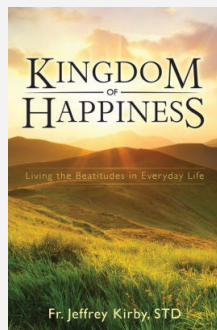
Thursday Women's Bible Study

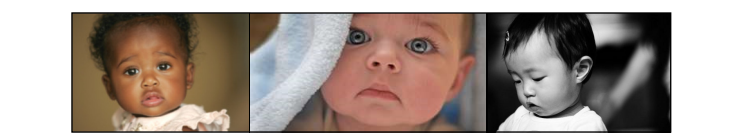
