SAINT FORMATION
Part 1 – Where Is Your Treasure?
Matthew 6:1 – 34

“For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be (Matthew 6:21).” I still remember the day, while at a pastor’s conference, that a respected Old Testament scholar read that verse, and then asked us the question, “Where is your treasure?” Immediately, the Holy Spirit convicted me of a horrifying truth. In March 1989 I began following Jesus for love of him, he was my treasure. Then, as years went by and I became more serious about studying Sacred Scripture, ever so subtly my heart began gravitating toward another treasure, studying about God instead of loving God. My heart crushed, by the grace of God, I sought to re-direct my first love toward God Himself.

In Matthew chapter 6, Jesus’s words burrow deep within our hearts, if we let them, to unearth our greatest treasure. Do we help the poor, pray, fast, and labor for material goods for love of God and neighbor, or to take pride in our spiritual advancement compared to others, or to provide security for self and family motivated by anxiety? In the weeks to come we will walk step by step through this chapter, calling upon the Holy Spirit to purify our motives and to re-direct our hearts, if necessary, to the greatest treasure of all—God and His Kingdom of Perfect Love that never disappoints or comes to an end. Between now and next week, I invite you, with me, to ask Jesus to reveal where our personal treasure really is, because that is where our heart is, too.
