SAINT FORMATION

Part 2 – Where Is Your Treasure? Almsgiving Matthew 6:1-4

In Genesis 3 we read that the serpent is the craftiest of all creatures. Satan subtly works in our lives to misdirect love. For example, perhaps you have heard people involved in almsgiving, helping the needy, say they do it because it makes them feel so good. Also, some people performing works of charity make sure you know how much they help others, slipping in such comments as if just in passing. Their words expose their misdirected love. In Matthew 6:1-4, Jesus says they have received their reward in full already, that being self-satisfaction and perhaps being praised by others.

God is our greatest possible love and treasure, after Him comes those whom He loves, which is everyone, even the people we struggle with. Remember, love wills the good of others, God and neighbors. Almsgiving falls under the seventh commandment, which of course follows the first six and that for a reason. Our first love and treasure is God, commandments one through three. Then comes love for families (who are our neighbors), for which reason we aim to respect all life by living chastely, charitably, truthfully, and orderly, commandments four through ten, for love of God and families. The reward for such love is the greatest treasure possible—LOVE Himself, who is greater than all we can see, think, or imagine.
