<b>SAINT FORMATION</b> <b>Part 3A – Where Is Your Treasure? Prayer</b> <b>Matthew 6:5-15</b> To begin, just a reminder, Jesus's teaching on prayer here is located within a longer teaching section that began in chapter 5 and will conclude with chapter 7. This teaching section began with the Beatitudes which, according to Catholic tradition, lay out the path toward the Beatific Vision and true happiness. God wants you to be truly happy, and that happiness has everything to do with Whom we treasure most and how we live in response to that Treasure. With that in mind, let us begin reflecting on Jesus's teaching on prayer by starting at the end. Jesus concludes his teaching by saying, "If you forgive others their transgressions, your heavenly Father will forgive you. But if you do not forgive others, neither will your Father forgive your transgressions (6:14-15)." Jesus knew people would have to pray in public, just as he did, especially in the temple and synagogues. His command to not show off and babble in prayer means to focus on our deepest interior, our heart, our core, not on exterior trappings to obtain praise from people for our devotedness or attempt to manipulate God with many meaningless words. Remember, in chapter 5 Jesus commanded us to be perfect as our heavenly Father is perfect, loving and praying for our enemies, just like he did from the Cross. We cannot be truly happy in life unless we love and forgive everyone, even enemies. Such love and forgiveness necessitates treasuring the God of perfect love above all else, imploring Him in prayer to make our hearts like His. Then, and only then, will the following words of Jesus become a reality for us, "I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and your joy may be complete (John 15:11)."
