50 Days of Easter

The purpose of observing the 40 days of Lent is to discipline ourselves, develop or refine our religious practices and serve others, to improve at living as Catholic Christians. We observe Lent so that we can live our baptism more fully.

During the 50 days of Easter we are called to live out our baptism. Easter is intended to help us celebrate what it means to be a person of faith.

Living out our baptismal promises is not something we do in isolation. Joined to Christ in Baptism we are adopted children of God the Father and members of the Church and have received the gift of the Holy Spirit. As members of the Body of Christ, we are called to actively live out our faith with and for others. Specifically, we must seek to transform the world by living our faith as individuals, in our family, community, and society.

Transform/Live Out Our Faith, how can we do this? As St. Francis of Assisi said "Preach the Gospel at all times. Use words if necessary."—and is intended to say that proclaiming the Gospel by example is more virtuous than actually proclaiming with voice. The Fruit of the Spirit—charity, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, generosity, gentleness, faithfulness, modesty, self-control, and chastity. (Galatians 5:22-23).

Easter is intended to help us celebrate everything that is good, which is beneficial to us spiritually, physically, emotionally and intellectually. We celebrate because we recognize that *everything good comes from God (James 1:17)* and is granted to us through Christ.
