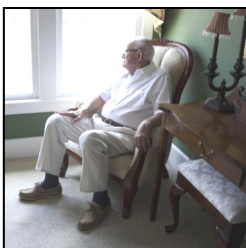

Gatekeeper Training— April 10 at 5:30 pm

Do you know an elder in the community who is isolated, has no advocate, and may need help or support?

The Area Agency Aging Gatekeeper program enables the community to identify people in need of help. The elders who are referred to the program are isolated and have little or no support system to act on their behalf as they experience serious difficulties that compromise their ability to live independently.

The role of the Gatekeeper is to recognize the signs and symptoms that may indicate an older adult is in need of assistance and support and then refer them to Klamath and Lake Counsel on Aging (541) 205-5400 where they will receive the help they need.

Gatekeeper training is at St. Pius X (location TBD), this Tuesday, April 10 at 5:30 pm. Everyone is welcome and we encourage all Homebound Ministers to attend the training.
