Have you been to St. Francis de Sales Cathedral? If so, then you know how beautiful this historic church is and how blessed we are to call it our mother church.

If you haven’t, the Cathedral, built in 1906, is located in Baker City. Although parishioners and visitors from afar have enjoyed its quiet grace for over 100 years, it was the local parishioners who have watched over its welfare. With major repairs looming on the horizon, the Diocese is inviting us all to participate in the new Cathedral Conservation Collection to be held once a year on or near January 24th, the Feast Day of St. Francis de Sales, our patron saint.

The fund will be managed by the Diocese and will be used for major repairs of the building only. Boiler replacement, ceiling remodel, exterior stone repairs and plumbing upgrades are a few examples. Routine maintenance of the church building will continue to be supported by the local parishioners.
