Please be sure to attend one of the two trainings.</p>	<p>QPR Training—October 8th</p> <p>QPR stands for Question, Persuade, and Refer – the 3 simple steps anyone can learn to help save a life from suicide.</p> <p>Just as people trained in CPR and the Heimlich Maneuver help save thousands of lives each year, people trained in QPR learn how to recognize the warning signs of a suicide crisis and how to question, persuade, and refer someone to help. Each year thousands of Americans are saying "Yes" to saving the life of a friend, colleague, sibling, or neighbor.</p> <p>QPR Gatekeeper course will be held in the Parish Hall on Sunday, October 8th at 6:30pm. The training is approximately one hour.</p> <p>Some studies show that suicide is the second leading cause of death for those in their early teens or twenties. 
Book Discussion
