Healing Our Divisions

Dear St. Pius X Parishioners,

Political, racial, gender, socio-economic, and religious divisions dominate U.S. society and the world. Marital, family, work, and personal-internal conflict disturb peace in our homes and workplace. What lies at the heart of all this division? What must happen to resolve all this conflict? According to Christian tradition, human nature must be healed for divine-human -environmental peace and unity to become a reality. The whole point of the Roman Catholic faith is to heal human nature and perfectly reunite humans with God, one another, and the environment.

God heals our human nature by infusing us with His grace through the Sacred Liturgy and Sacraments, and by our response to His grace in corporal and spiritual works of mercy and prayer. That's where faith formation comes in for children, youth, and adults. Faith formation prepares us for meaningful and intentional participation in the Sacred Liturgy, reception of God's healing grace in the Sacraments, and for works of mercy and prayer informed by the Wisdom of God in the faith of the Church.

As we begin this faith formation year, we, first of all, encourage you to at least weekly join our parish family for the Eucharistic liturgy. Second, we invite you to prayerfully read through this brochure, asking God to help you and/or your family discern which faith formation opportunities may best serve the healing of your nature for the resolution of the divisions and conflicts in your personal life and society.

First Confession & Communion registration forms for children in first and second grade should be completed and turned in to the Faith Formation office ASAP. Formation begins Sunday September 13 at 10:15 AM in the Parish Hall. We provide a 2-year formation program in accord with the Diocese of Baker norms. We aim to create a family room environment. We use diocesan approved curriculum from Our Sunday Visitor, supplemented by materials from Education in Virtue.

Confirmation registration forms for adolescents in grades 5-8 should be completed and turned in to the Faith Formation office ASAP. Formation begins on Sunday, September 13 at 10:115 AM in the Parish Hall. We provide a 2-year formation program in accordance with the Diocese of Baker norms. We aim to create a family room environment. We use diocesan approved curriculum from Our Sunday Visitor, supplemented by materials from Education in Virtue.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults registration forms for children and adults ages 9 – adult should be completed and turned into the Faith Formation office ASAP. Formation for children ages 9 – 18 begins Sunday, September 13 in the Parish Hall. Formation for adults begins Tuesday, September 15 at 6:30 PM in the Parish Hall. Formation classes are an 8 month program, using the diocesan recommended SYMBOLON. We aim to create a comfortable, conversational environment.

<u>Marriage</u> forms should be picked up from, completed, and turned in to the Parish Office. Formation will be scheduled upon reception of completed forms.

Faith Formation families:

All members of St. Pius X Faith Formation team strive to provide a welcoming environment where children, adults, and families can open their hearts to Christ. We continue to work on the three R's Reverence, Respect, and Responsibly.

With the developments of the pandemic and the changing recommendations from the government, the state, and the diocese we are going to continue to be mindful of the health and safety of all our brothers and sisters.

Due to contact tracing requirements, everyone must register for each class they are planning to attend and provide contact information i.e. phone number and/or email address that will allow us to contact you. Children attending Faith Formation classes on Sunday morning or Youth Group for our teens need to complete a registration form with contact information and liability forms signed.

Class sizes will be small groups of 10 in each classroom if possible. If a class has more than 10 students, we will find a larger classroom that will allow them to physically distance appropriately. The teen room space and size will allow us to have more students and the new furniture allows the teens to appropriately dis-

All children please go directly to your proper classroom, as we strongly encourage to not gather in the hallways or go to other classrooms. Parents please walk your younger children to their classroom. Teens enter the Youth Room through the back door.

Catechists will dismiss and walk students grades 1 and 2 through the doors closest to the church. Parents please wait for your children at this exit. Grades 3 and 4 will dismiss and be escorted out the doors closest to the rectory; parents please pick up your children at this door. Grades 5 through 8 will exit through the doors close to the rectory after the younger kids and will go straight to their family's car. The teens will exit from the back door of the teen room and will go straight to their family's car. Older Siblings will not be permitted to pick up younger siblings—this will allow for proper distancing in the hallway.

Each desk will be sanitized before and after class.

Each student will have their own assigned seat with sneeze guards in place for grades 1-6 and their own pencil box that will be sanitized after each class.

Children and adults will need to sanitize their hands before entering the classroom.

Catechists are encouraged to use our beautiful outdoor space, weather permitting, to allow lessons in the fresh air instead of closed in spaces. Please watch for weekly emails and instructions if the class will be enjoying the sunshine and fresh air.

Please ensure your child eats before class as the parish is not offering coffee and donuts or breakfasts. We have put together a list of instructions to provide you with the best support possible in your efforts to educate your children on the ways of Christ.

Reverence, Respect, and Responsibility toward self and all persons and things in and around the church property are expected.

Please be punctual. Class begins at 10:15 and ends at 11:25. Please park your vehicle and get out to pick up your child at the exits.

Two years of Faith Formation attendance is required to receive Sacraments per diocesan guidelines.

The families who are completing Faith Formation at home in preparation for Sacraments will need to meet with their Catechists once a month.
