National Eucharistic Pilgrimage: Oregon Route—Serra Route to Travel through Diocese of Baker—<https://dioceseofbaker.org/nep>

On May 17, 2024, Pentecost Sunday, four processions of the Eucharist with accompanying perpetual pilgrims will depart from the four North, South, East, and west borders of the United States en route to the National Eucharistic Congress, which begins on July 17, 2024, in Indianapolis, Indiana. Each procession will mainly travel by vehicle, with a specially modified van as a traveling Eucharistic Adoration Chapel.

The route beginning in San Francisco, the Serra Route, will enter the Diocese of Baker from the Diocese of Reno on May 26, the Sunday of Memorial Day Weekend. It will depart from Blessed Sacrament Church, Ontario, on Memorial Day, May 27, in a Solemn Eucharistic Procession to Corpus Christi, Fruitland, ID. Please visit link for detailed information.
