

Eucharistic Miracles of the World, designed by Blessed Carlo Acutis, an Italian teenager who died from leukemia at the age of 15.

This Vatican-approved international exhibit was designed and created by Blessed Carlo Acutis. Carlo, an artist, cartoonist and avid computer enthusiast, created the art for the panels before his death from leukemia at age 15. His goal during his short life was to help bring others closer to Jesus through awareness of the mystery of the Eucharist. Carlo received the sacrament of the Eucharist daily and desired to share the joy of Christ's presence with the world through his Godgiven talents. This exhibit is presented in the United States by the Carlo Acutis Association.
