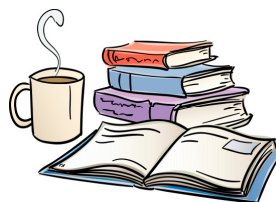

Training for the temporary arrangement for Acolytes and Altar Servers—June 3 11:00 AM.

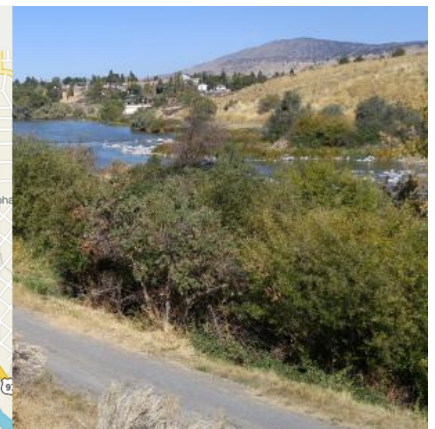
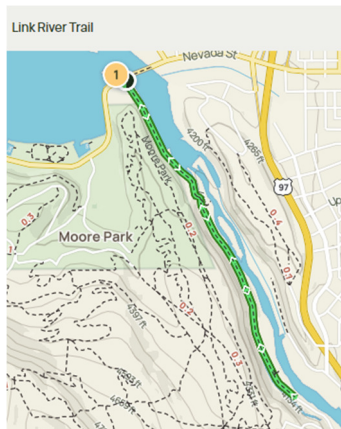
