## 2022 Bishop's Annual Appeal Faith Finds the Way

The 2022 Bishop's Annual Appeal theme is *Faith Finds the Way*. We are called to reflect on the paralyzed man whose friend's faith found the way to Jesus for his healing. We are encouraged to stand up and carry the Gospel forward with love, full of hope that faith will find the way.

The overall Appeal participation goal is 21% and the supporting financial target is \$635,000. For our Parish the participation goal is 112 families with a supporting target of \$40,937.
