It is with great pleasure that Mt. Calvary Catholic Cemetery board of directors and employees invite you to the 'Memorial Day Mass at the Cemetery'.

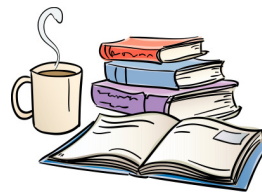

### All Eucharistic Ministers, Lectors, and Altar Servers:

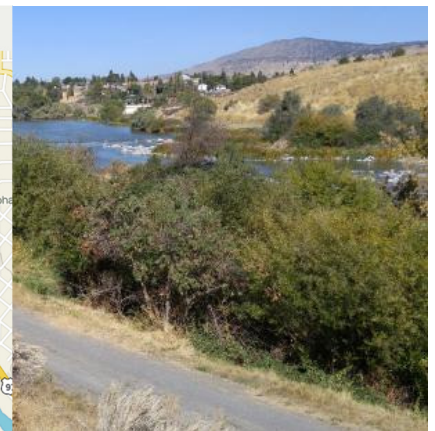
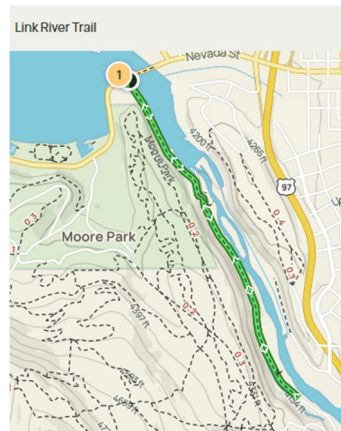
- Please arrive 20 minutes before mass to review any possible questions of the new sanctuary layout
